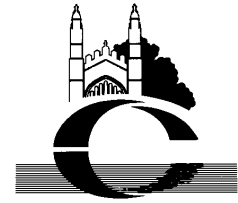

**Notice of official restriction of river traffic
Wednesday 5th November Fireworks 2008, Midsummer Common, Cambridge**

I write to inform you that Cambridge City Council have been granted permission to temporarily restrict the movement of river traffic on the River Cam between the hours of 19.00 and 20.00 on Wednesday 5th November 2008 between the Fort St George Public House and Cutter Ferry footbridge. This closure is in accordance with relevant byelaws and in order to ensure the safety of people attending the 5th November Fireworks, as this area of the river includes part of the fallout zone for the fireworks.

River traffic will therefore be suspended in the area immediately behind the firework fallout area for this period and marshalls shall be on duty to report any breaches with a view to prosecution proceedings.

In the interests of safety, mooring will be prohibited in the area immediately behind the firework display area between midday and 8pm on Wednesday 5th November. This area will be indicated by metal fencing and mooring prohibited signs. You are kindly requested to move your boat in good time for the above event. Please note that Cambridge City Council accept no liability for any damage to boats located in the identified area.

Double mooring will be accepted by the City Council, obviously where the Conservators of the River Cam permit this. If you have any queries regarding mooring, please contact Teresa White on 01223 457532.
