Temporary Closure of Recreational Waterway - Amendments

NOTICE is hereby given under Section 15 of the Anglian Water Authority Act 1977 as amended by the Water Act 1989, that the following locks will be closed to navigation on the **River Great Ouse system**:

Bottisham Lock (River Cam) from 26 February 2007 until 5 April 2007 (inclusive) to drain down and inspect the lock chamber and refurbish the guillotine gate and vee doors.

Hemingford Lock from 5 March 2007 until 5 April 2007 (inclusive) to drain down and inspect the lock chamber and refurbish the guillotine gate.

Isleham Lock (River Lark) from 16 April 2007 until 14 May 2007 (inclusive) to drain down and inspect the lock chamber.

Castle Mills Lock from 12 March 2007 until 5 April 2007 (inclusive) to demolish the downstream landing stage in preparation for constructing the new landing stage.

On-going high flow conditions have unfortunately resulted in delays to works and the Environment Agency regrets any inconvenience this may cause.
