To enable concrete to be poured, as part of the reconstruction of the Rail Bridge upstream of Ely, boats may be delayed passage for up to 1 hour through the works whilst materials are being taken across the river. You are advised to take care when approaching the site and follows instructions issued by the Contractors. Further Navigation Notices in respect of this on-going work will be issued in the future.

You are reminded that a Navigation Restriction is currently in place for these works until 31st March 2008.
