DETAILS FOR CALCULATION OF REGISTRATION FEES FOR 2012/2013 with effect from 1st April 2012

The basic charge for the type of boat is as set out in Part 1 below, such charge being multiplied by the multiplier shown opposite the category of owner in Part 2 below.

*Where the size of an engine or its presence at all is not immediately obvious, the category requiring the higher payment for the size of vessel shall be appropriate until such time as the owner provides satisfactory access for a member of the Conservancy's staff to inspect the vessel (or else satisfactory certification) and the appropriate registration category has been confirmed by the Control Officer.

N.B. Craft Recovery - twice the relevant registration fee for boat recovered with a minimum of £50 and subsequent storage charge 25% of the registration fee per week with a minimum of £15.00 or by agreement with the Conservators. Where a sunken boat is recovered the charge will be "at cost" with a minimum charge of £250.
